CAS Member Groups and CAS National Partners are invited to put forward nominations for this award to celebrate the national contributions made by a company in the fight against HIV/AIDS. Past award winners include: Pfizer Canada Inc., Delta Hotels, CANPAR, Molson Breweries, MAC AIDS Fund and GlaxoSmithKline in partnership with Shire BioChem.

Eligibility Criteria

The following is a list of eligibility criteria for this award:

- recipient must have demonstrated a long-term commitment to the AIDS movement in Canada
- recipient will have demonstrated their leadership either throughout Canada or within their local community or region impacting on the national community at large

Outstanding examples and achievements of leadership on the part of the company include:

- Significant national leadership in an organization's commitment to supporting the work of CAS and/or helping communities respond to HIV/AIDS across Canada
- Significant contributions to national HIV/AIDS advocacy work and/or otherwise promoting the rights and empowerment of persons living with HIV/AIDS across Canada as an advocate, role model or mentor

Guidelines

Multiple submissions of a single nominee will not be given any additional consideration. Nominations can be submitted by Full or Associate Members of CAS or CAS National Partners. General conflict of interest guidelines must be adhered to (e.g., if you have or have had a personal relationship with a specific organization or a member of that organization, you should not submit a nomination for the organization).

Submission Requirements

All nominations must include the company name, representative contact information and a short description of the nominee's achievements (300 words or less) highlighting the nominee's national involvement in the fight against HIV/AIDS.

Selection Process

All nominees will be reviewed by the Executive Committee of the CAS Board, who in consultation with the Executive Director, makes a prioritized selection of three award recipients, and then passes on these recommendations to the Board. The CAS Board of Directors will select the final candidate.
